### **TRANSPORT DEPUTY MINISTER HANDS OVER STATE-OF-THE –ART INFRASTRUCTURE TO MPUMALANGA SCHOOLS**

The Deputy Minister of Transport, Ms. Sindisiwe Chikunga will officially hand over state-of-the-art educational facilities and learning infrastructure to pupils at the Inkomazi Senior and Shilobanyi Secondary Schools in Mpumalanga on Friday, 25 May 2018.

Deputy Minister Chikunga will hand over a science laboratory, a refurbished library and refurbished ablution facilities for benefit of learners at the two schools as part of government's continued effort to provide sustainable and dignified basic sanitation services.

The educational and learning infrastructure was built through the corporate social investment initiative of the Airports Company South Africa (Acsa), a State Owned Entity of the Department of Transport.

Deputy Minister Chikunga will be joined during the official handover, by the Mpumalanga MEC for Community Safety, Security and Liaison, Mr. Pat Ngomane, MEC for Education Mr Sibusiso Malaza and the CEO of ACSA, Mr. Bongani Maseko among other dignitaries.
