## **MINISTER OF TRANSPORT TO LAUNCH ONLINE PRE-BOOKING SERVICE**

The Minister of Transport, Dr. Bonginkosi Nzimande, together with the Gauteng Transport MEC, Ismail Vadi, will launch the new online booking services to obtain vehicle driving licenses and related services at the Centurion licensing station. The system is developed by the Road Traffic Management Corporation (RTMC).

The online services are envisaged to ease the process of applying for vehicle driving licenses and learner license. The service will also promote efficient service delivery and combat corruption by minimising the manipulation of the process by unscrupulous officials and applicants.

The system will first be rolled-out in the Gauteng province and will later be available to other provinces.
