

# CARRIAGE OF ALCOHOL-BASED HAND SANITISERS BY PASSENGERS



- ✓ Carriage of alcohol-based sanitisers by Passengers are accepted as part of Medicinal or Toiletry Articles.
- ✓ The sanitisers are acceptable as both Carry-on baggage and Checked Baggage.
- ✓ It is recommended that alcohol-based sanitisers be carried as hand luggage to avoid fire hazards.
- ✓ Flip-top bottles are prone to leak due to cabin pressure fluctuations; use screw top bottles or any other means to prevent leakage.
- ✓ Take extra care to prevent leakage when the sanitiser is packed with equipment containing lithium batteries.
